



## Tips and Guidelines for the Class of 2026

Here is a list of school supplies and general information to prepare you for the upcoming school year.

### Common School Supplies

- Make sure you have an adequate amount of writing utensils (pens and pencils), highlighters, folders, and notebooks.
- Your teachers will provide specific information regarding supplies during Freshman Orientation when you walk your class schedule.

### Required Calculator

- A TI-84 Graphing calculator is required for all mathematics courses at CBC.

### Supplies Purchased Through CBC Online Bookstore

The CBC Online Bookstore, hosted by MBS Direct (Barnes & Noble College), opens on July 25, 2022. Families are required to visit the online bookstore website (<https://bnck-12.com/cbchs-stl>) anytime between July 25 and the date of their student orientation in August to purchase required course textbooks, materials, and online licenses and pay any accompanying fees. ### Dress Code

- Students are required to wear tennis shoes (no boots, sandals, etc.), dress shorts and pants (no cargo), belts, and a collared shirt.
- Appropriately-sized logos on sweaters, crewneck sweatshirts, or quarter-zip pullovers are limited ONLY to CBC or apparel brand logos. (No hooded sweatshirts or jackets permitted).
- Dress shirts, dress shoes, and ties are only required on All School Mass days.

**What is the schedule for Freshman Orientation?**

**How do I set up my son's lunch account?**

- ALL new families are asked to setup an account, even if you choose not to fund it electronically.
- Using an internet browser, navigate to [www.myschoolbucks.com](http://www.myschoolbucks.com) and register for an account. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to the e-mail address you are asked to provide.
- Click on the link included in the confirmation e-mail to activate your account.
- Activate your account and begin adding the requested information related to your CBC student. You will also need the SCHOOL NAME and YOUR CBC STUDENT'S DATE OF BIRTH (or CBC Student ID#).
- You may begin funding your student's account as early as Thursday, August 11, 2022.

**What is the dress code for orientation?**

- Active wear (gym shorts, t-shirt, tennis shoes). On August 10<sup>th</sup>, please provide your son with a collared shirt for their yearbook photo.

**What are the school day hours?**

- Each day starts at 8:40 AM and ends at 3:00 PM.
