Dear Parents of the Class of 2026:

As you know, the St. Louis Archdiocese is blessed to have many high schools working to educate young men and women spiritually and personally, as well as academically. While our schools engage in healthy competition athletically, we are committed to cooperation when it comes to the well-being of our students. For that reason, administrators, athletic directors, campus ministers and other members of the high schools meet on a regular basis.

Your sons will continue to socialize with students from many of our Catholic high schools. In order to support you in your parenting responsibilities, the high schools have joined together to form the St. Louis Catholic Secondary Schools Coalition. Together, we sponsor a series of informational meetings for parents at the beginning of each school year. These meetings explore issues facing teens and provide parents with tools to help their children make good and safe decisions. We have engaged West County Psychological Associates to provide the speakers who lead these sessions.

Due to the potential for continuing uncertainties related to COVID-19 health and safety protocols, **both in-person and online presentations will be available to parents for the upcoming August 2022 sessions so that you may choose the setting that feels right for you.**

Each freshman must have at least one parent or legal guardian attend one of the sessions. These presentations are **for parents or guardians only**--students should NOT attend.

Option 1: Attend a Live Presentation

The live presentations will occur at the locations listed on the enclosed attendance form, which details dates and locations. To attend a live presentation, please choose the location and date that best suits your schedule. Doors open for the sessions at 6:30 PM. The presentations begin promptly at 7:00 PM. and last until approximately 8:15 PM. ***Please do not call the host parish.***

BRING THE ENCLOSED ATTENDANCE FORM to the session, making sure that your CBC student's name and our school are printed on it. Turning in this sheet will let us know that you have attended the session. The sheets are labeled so that the host school will know you are from CBC High School.

Option 2: Attend an Online Live Webinar

In order for all parents to have the option to attend a presentation that feels safe to them, online live webinar sessions will be offered again this year.

To attend a webinar, please choose the date and time that best suits your schedule from the list below, and **utilize the link in order to register**. After registering, you will receive a link for joining the webinar along with reminders about the upcoming webinar as the date approaches. Please note that the time for the session on August 10th is 2:00 PM in the afternoon in order to provide a daytime option.

Attendance at webinars is monitored and our school will be notified of your attendance. There is no need to use your “attendance form” when choosing the webinar option.
